
REMOVING THE TOP HOUSING ON EM-1040

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Remove the drip trays and water tank from the unit.



With unit upside down, remove all the screws from the bottom of the unit.

Then you will need to use a flat screwdriver to put in Flat parts of base and push back the clip. Pull up And press the screwdriver at the same time.

Do all around and take the bottom panel off.



With the bottom off, you will need to take off one
Of the orange tubes by using plyers to squeeze clip
And pull back hose.



This is what it will look like with tube off.



Now you need to remove the 2 screws by where the water tank goes.



Remove the screws on the underneath side of the drip side of the unit.

Then remove the screws from the espresso side.

Then turn unit back upright.





Remove the screws from around where the water is poured in on the drip side. Note there is a hidden screw behind the hinged lid part. You need to pull back on the shower cap and remove from the lid to be able to access this screw and remove. Remove all the screws around the top.



Take a flat screwdriver and wedge between the top part and pull up. Note the top lid has clips that press it in so you need to pop up and pull. Do on both sides of the unit and then you should be able to remove the top lid.



Once you have the top lid off, you will be able to access the steam valve, pump and boiler of the unit to service.
